Located on 13 Mile Road between Ryan and Dequindre, North side of 13 Mile.

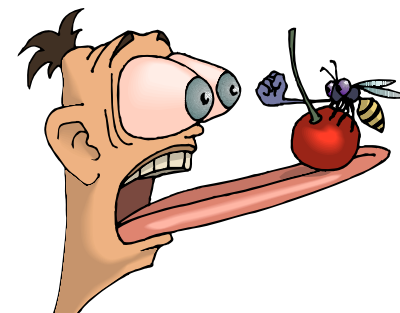

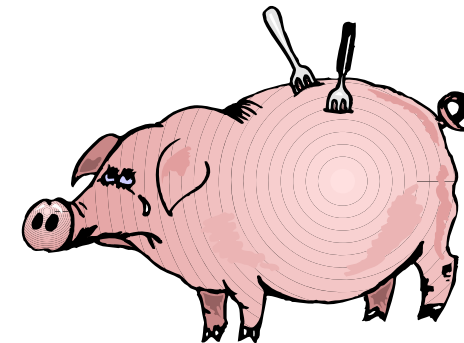
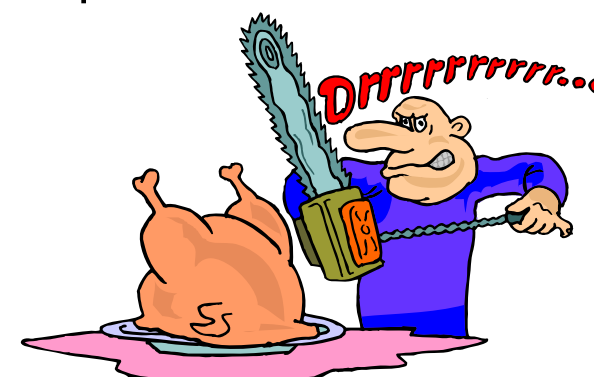
