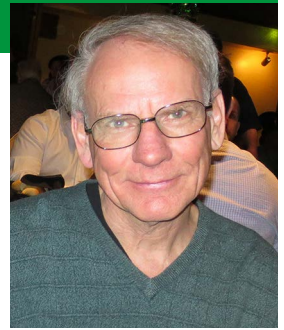

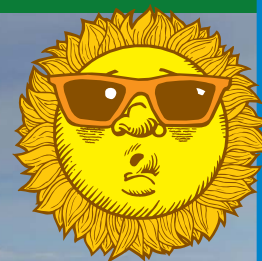

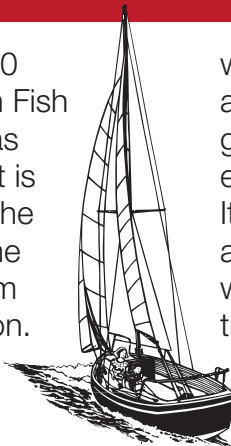
Tin Fish Dinner & Full Moon Event

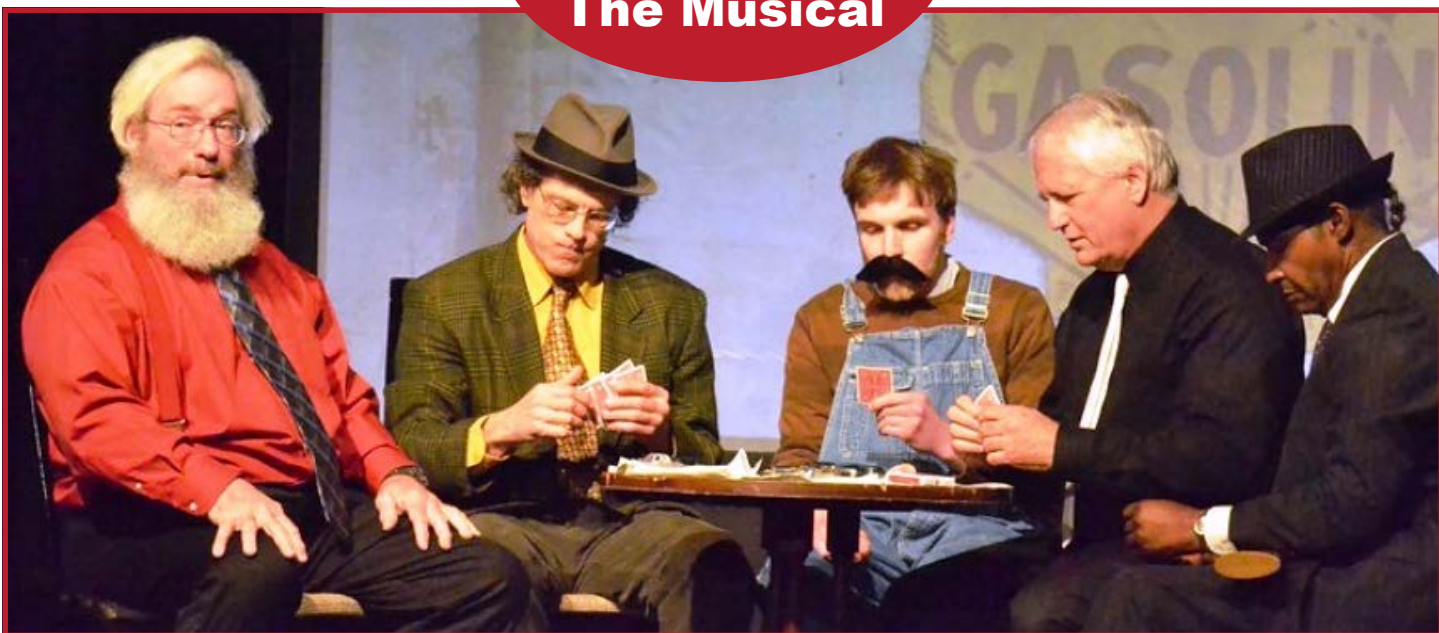
