

- The Super Bowl is measured in Roman numerals because a football season runs over two calendar years except for this year, the 50th anniversary is numbered 50.
- What current NFL teams have never played in a Super Bowl? Detroit Lions, Houston Texans, Jacksonville Jaguars, and Cleveland Browns.
- Over 700,000 footballs are produced annually for official NFL use and 72 of them are used for the Super Bowl.
 - No network footage exists of Super Bowl I. Supposedly it was taped over for a soap opera.
- 8 million pounds of guacamole and 14,500 tons of chips are consumed on Super Bowl Sundays.


