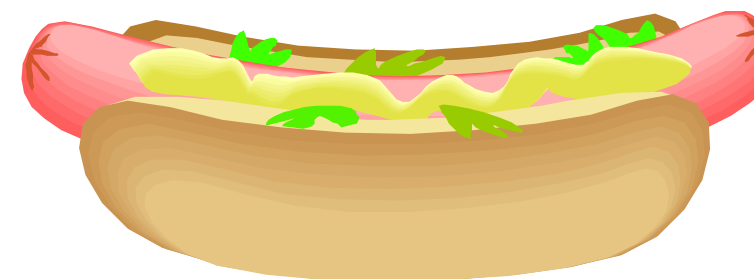

Thursday, July 14, 2005

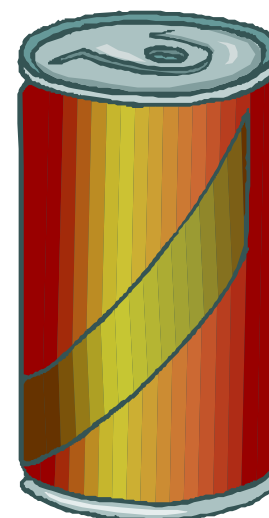
