



# Full Moon Sail

We sail Friday, June 9, which is actually two days before the full moon. (Hey, don't expect too much of us. This is done by committee).

- O **6:00-7:00 p.m.** Assemble at the gazebo at **A dock**, Jefferson Beach Marina, on Jefferson between 9 and 10 Mile Roads. Receive your boat assignments.
- O 7:00 p.m. SHARP! Shove off. We must be well into the lake before...
- O 7:28 p.m. Moon rise. Yes, time and tide and the moon wait for no woman or man. This is the feature event of the evening. There will be a prize of a bottle of Luna de Luna wine for the first person in the flotilla to spot the rising moon. All vessels will maintain radio contact on channel 71 for fleet coordination and to report moon sightings.
- O **9:08 p.m.** Sunset. We anticipate a rosy glow, the fabled "red sky at night," and the further mellowing of the now high-flying moon.
- O **10:00 p.m.** Return to dock (though individual vessels, of course, may stay out as long as they wish, until the passengers and crew start to mutiny).

In the event of rain, we will run this same scenario again Saturday, June 10; except the moon rise occurs at 8:40 p.m. and the shove-off time will be at 7:00 p.m. soft, not sharp.

The cost is \$15 per person, which includes sub sandwiches and snacks. You must provide for your own "special" food and drink requirements. All participants must wear soft-soled shoes with white or light-colored soles. Anyone who wears clod-hoppers will remain on the dock.

The 30 spots for this event are already filled, but contact Gregg Ronan, 586-979-9512, to get on the waiting list in case we acquire more vessels.


