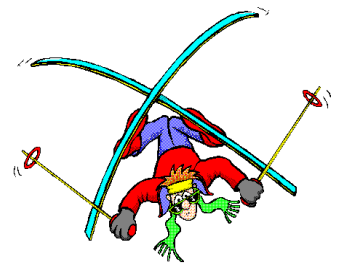



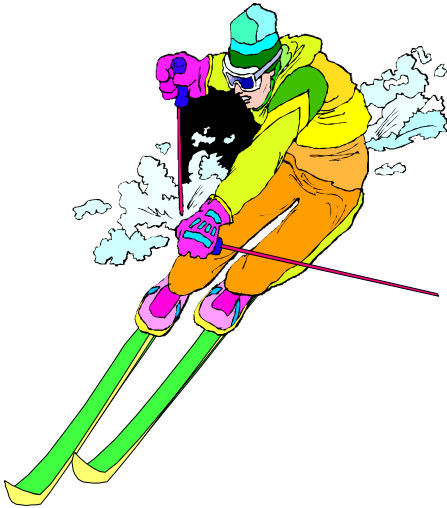

GM SKI CLUB RACING NEWS by Karen Brown

Exciting changes are in the works for this year's race season. The first change will be the elimination of the Mark II club trophies (nobody understood how the points were calculated and it was almost impossible to know how your club was doing) and the implementation of season-long team trophies based on an average of the individual racer's world cup points.

The second change that will go into effect this year, unless there is strong opposition from club members, is ending all races pertaining to world cup points and team trophies on Saturday. This should make the Saturday night banquet a lot more fun because all the year-end trophies will be awarded at that time. It will be especially fun for the world cup winners because they will have around 250 people cheering for them as they receive their awards instead of the 20 or so that generally show up on Sunday night. On Sunday, to replace the last race of the year, there will be a Dual Elimination Slalom race. Everyone will go through a one-run qualifying race, on their respective courses in the morning, and the top eight winners in each class will qualify for the race in the afternoon.

The PRESIDENT'S CORNER by Alan Toomey

Nominating Committee Has Been Formed As per the GM Ski Club By-Laws, the Club has now formed the nominating committee for the upcoming Board of Directors Election. The term of the board runs from May 1st for a period of 1 Year. The responsibility of the nominating committee is to solicit the membership and to submit qualified individual names such that they may be placed on the ballot and a list of the names of all the candidates for office shall be published and mailed at least 14 days prior to the election. "How To Prepare For The Ski Season"
