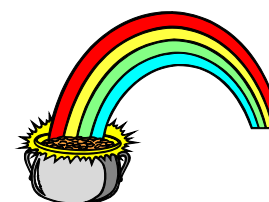

Ski rental is \$18.00. Snow board rental is \$28.00

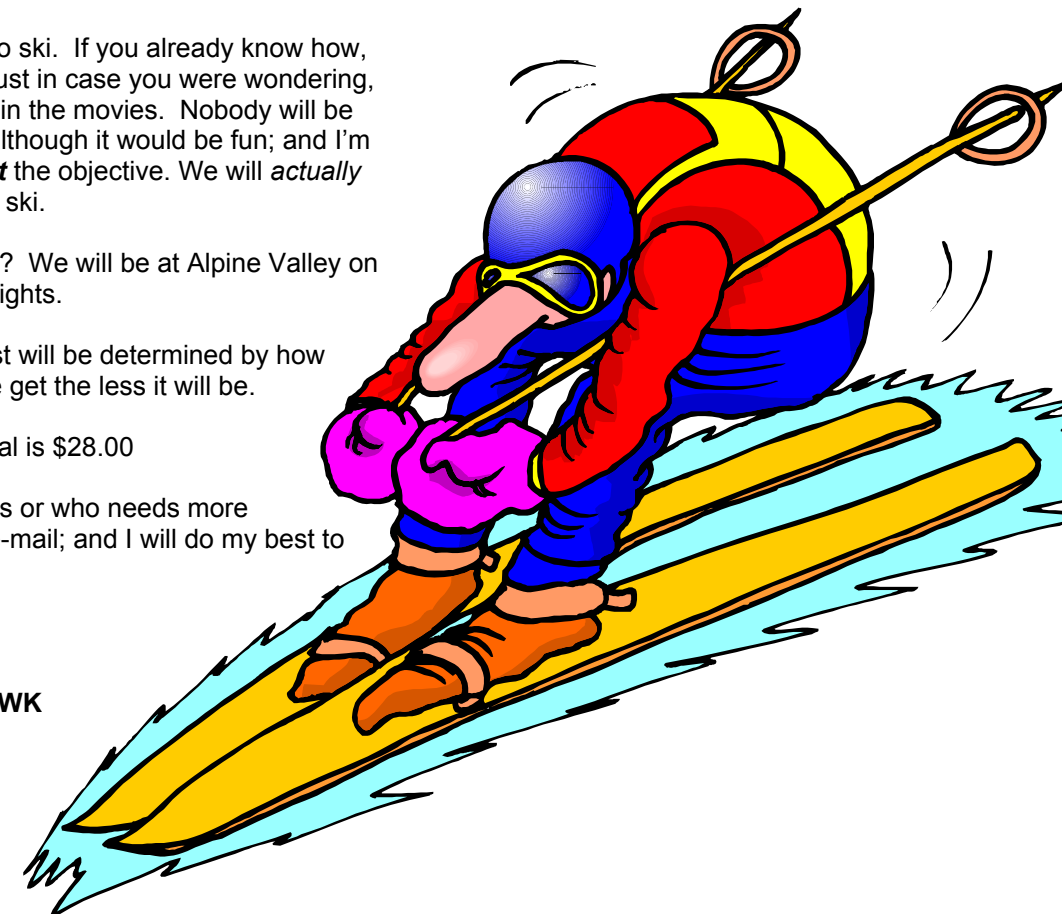

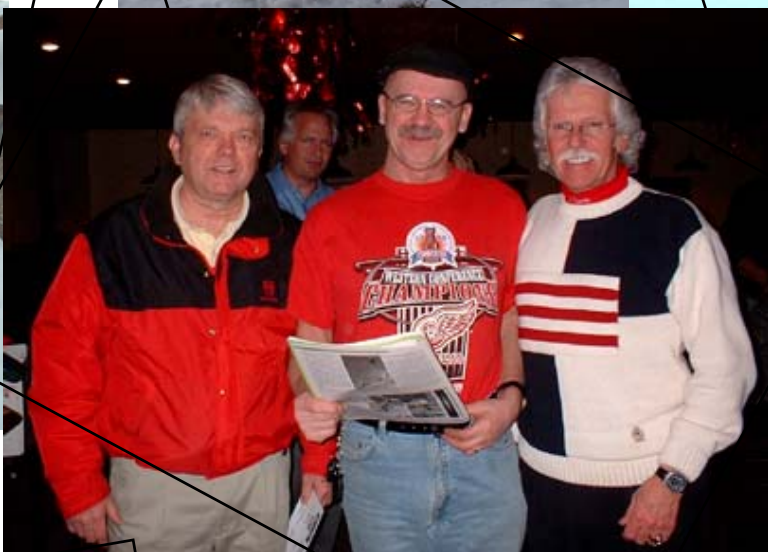
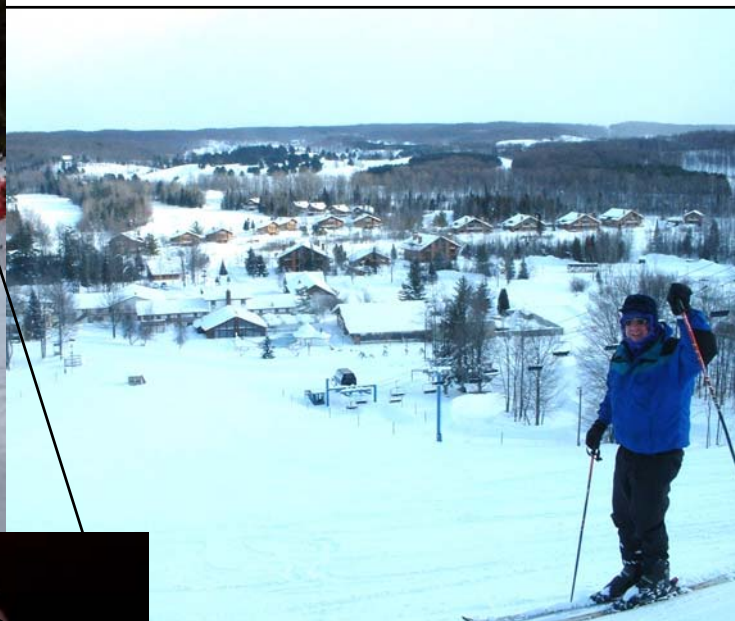
