SKIING AND THE LAW

# regarding the ski safety act in which a skier was denied damages for injuries sustained while skiing and colliding with a natural object, to wit a tree. The law in regards to that case is Michigan Compiled Laws (MCL) 408.342 which reads as follows:

**408.342. Ski areas**; **conduct of skiers**; **acceptance of risks** Sec. 22. **(1)** While in a ski area, each skier shall do all of the following: **(a)** Maintain reasonable control of his or her speed and course at all times. **(b)** Stay clear of snow-grooming vehicles and equipment in the ski areas. **(c)** Heed all posted signs and warnings. **(d)** Ski only in ski areas which are marked as open for skiing on the trail board described in section 6a(e). **(2)** Each person who participates in the sport of skiing accepts the dangers that inhere in that sport insofar as the dangers are obvious and necessary. Those dangers include, but are not limited to, injuries which can result from variations in terrain; surface or subsurface snow or ice conditions; bare spots; rocks, trees, and other forms of natural growth or debris; collisions with ski lift towers and their components, with other skiers, or with properly marked or plainly visible snow-making or snow-grooming equipment.

#### WHAT'S THIS "RACING CLASS" THING? by Roman Karwowski

Last month our esteemed President, Alan Toomey, explained the classifications of racers with age groups and handicaps. I would like to add to that by giving some more information regarding racing.

The MACC (Michigan Alpine Competition Committee) races four weekends a year at Boyne Mountain and one three day weekend at Searchmont. At Boyne Mountain we have our own hill called Superbowl. The public is barred from using that hill the entire day we are racing.

We have our own warming hut with bathrooms and a deck in front of the hut on which we have cook-outs, sell skis, eat lunch, and yes, drink a brew (only after racing of course). It's a party especially on a sunny day. People bring CD's and we have music. I haven't seen any dancing yet, but who knows.

Some people ( wives, husbands, and parents) bring their babies, dogs, and chairs to watch the races. We also have our own parking lot which is only a few yards from the chair lift. We have our things in the hut such as after-ski boots, lunches, and who knows what else. I've never heard of anything being taken.

Safety. I rode up the chair lift with a member of the Ski Patrol last race weekend and he told me that not one racer was hurt the whole season. That's about 350 racers taking about 18 runs through the race course, or 6000 runs give or take.

Not all racers show up every race weekend. As a racer, you only race whenever you want to. If it's too cold, or too icy, and you don't want to race, you don't have to. I race with eleven other people in my class. Yes, we are old and slow but we are racers. One is 80 years old, one is 76 years old and he beats me most of the time. The top man in our class is 71. I'll beat them yet (I'm younger). My age group is 50 and up. Every weekend it's "How you doing", "Have a good run", etc. The word is camaraderie. Come join us. Frank L. we miss you.
