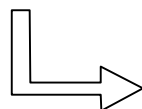

The next board meeting is Tuesday, June 18, at Chi Chi's, just south of 14 Mile Road and one block east of I-75.

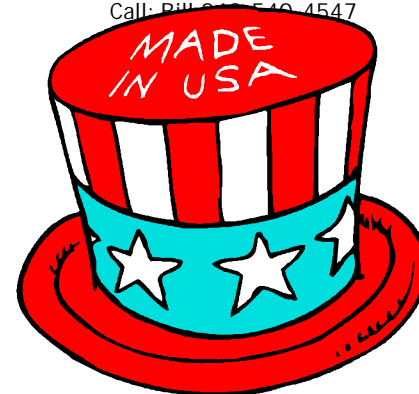
