etc. The location of the boat outing will be near

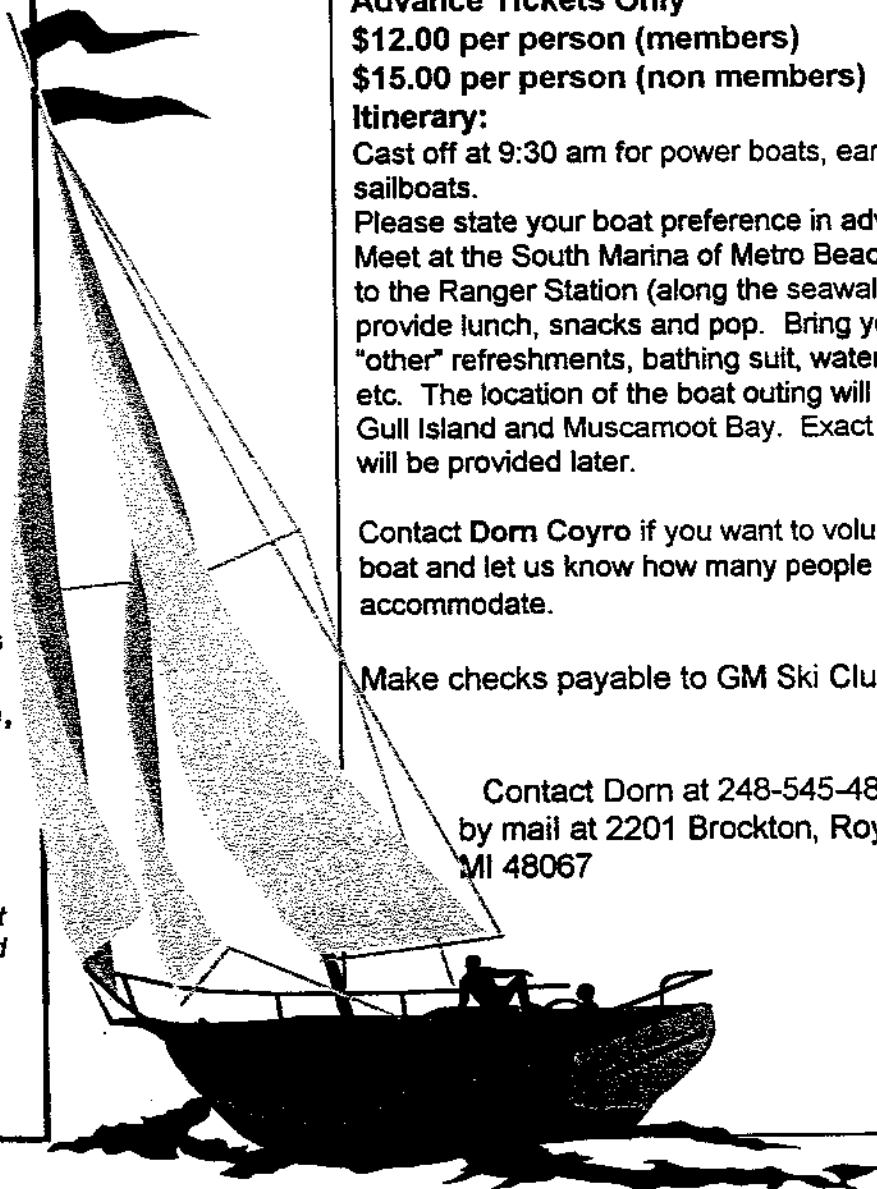
Gull Island and Muscamoot Bay. Exact location
