Come join and party with the friends of the Club in a wonderful social event.

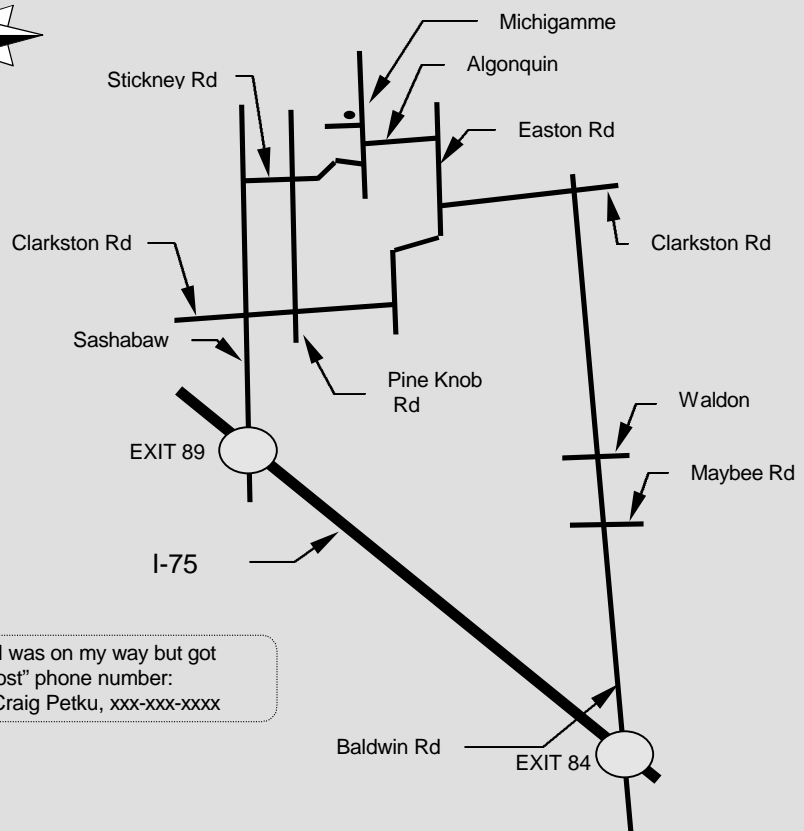

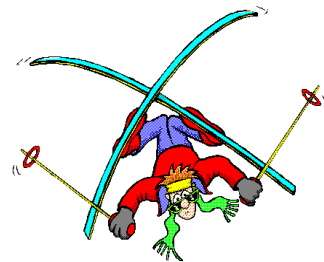

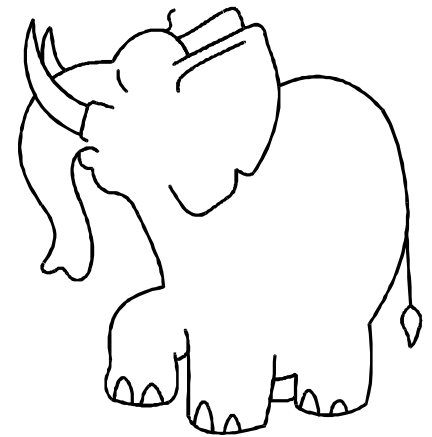
